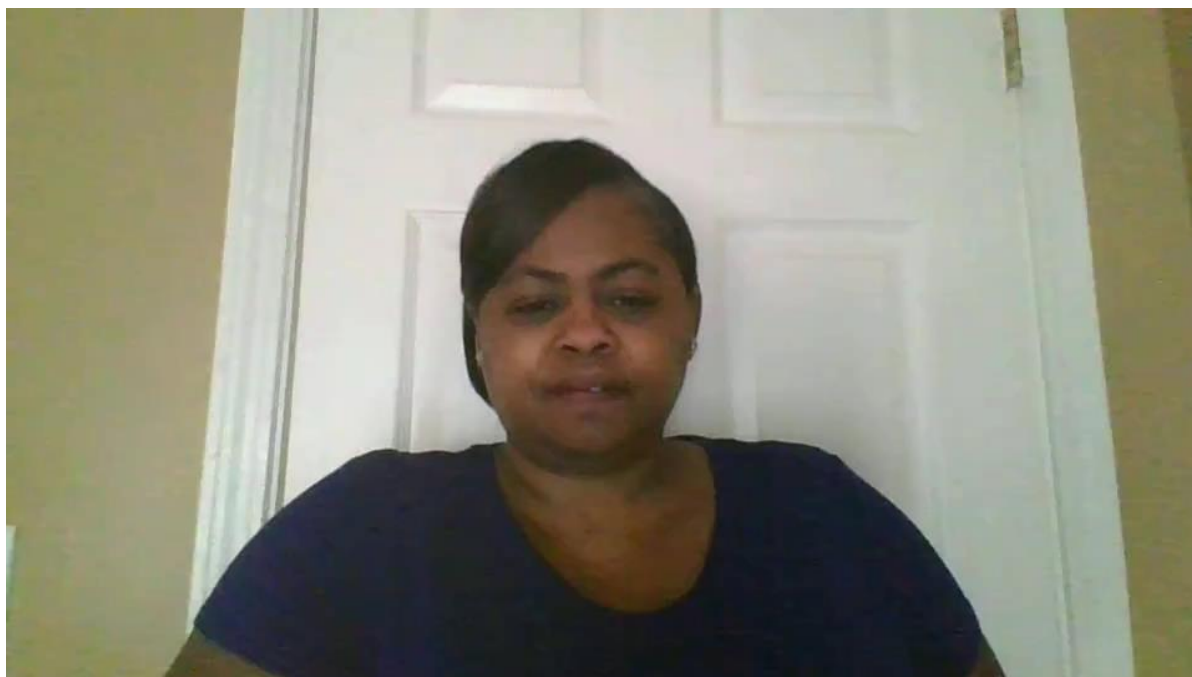

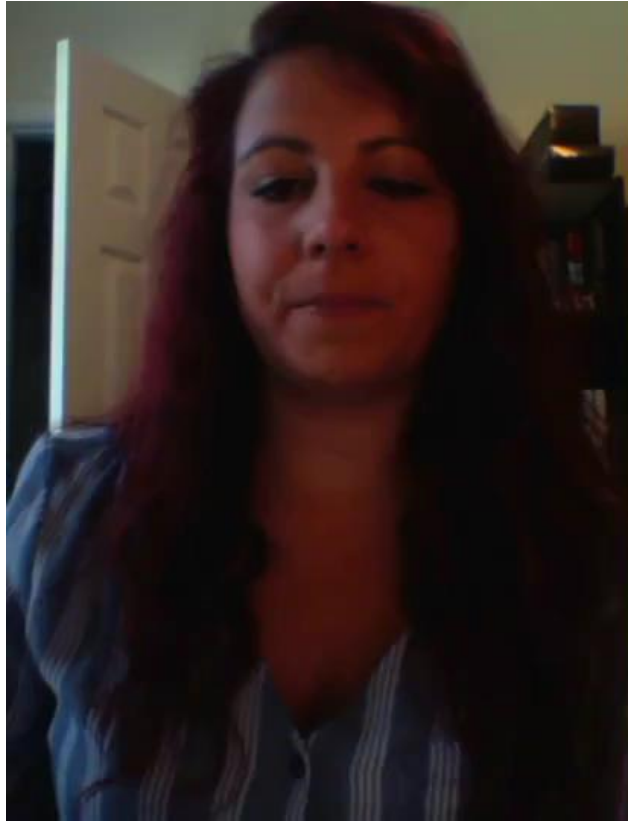

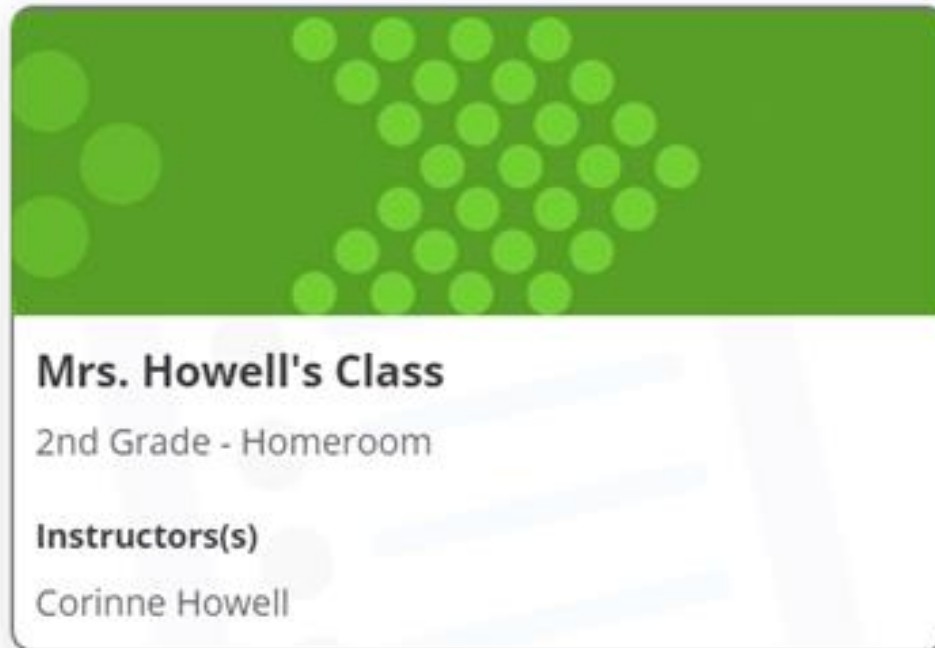

# Assessment and Feedback

- Administer and record running records quarterly at a minimum with additional administration for students on RTI (K-2)
- Clearly communicate grades and assignments

- Collect and assess assignments after each small group lesson for student formative/summative assessment and feedback.

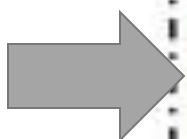

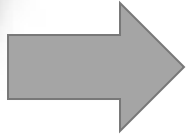
